

	<ul><li>Press once to display the Quick menu</li><li>Press twice to show the Settings menu</li></ul>			
С	Power/Brilliance key			
	<ul><li>Press to display the Display setup dialog</li><li>Press and hold to turn the unit to sleep mode</li></ul>			
D	Rotary knob			
	Menu and dialog operation:			
	<ul><li>turn to move up and down in menus and dialogs</li><li>turn to adjust a value</li></ul>			
	press to select a menu option and to enter the next menu level			
	In Standby and NFU mode:			
	• press and hold to activate Follow up (FU) mode			
	In FU mode:			
	turn to set the rudder angle			
	In automatic modes:			
	• turn to change the set heading/set course, press to re-activate automatic mode with current heading/course as reference

	Press to display the Work quick menu			
	Re-press to toggle between different work modes/profiles			
K	<b>Turn key</b> - Press to display the Turn quick menu			
L	Alarm key - Press to display the list of active alerts			


#### **The Power/Brilliance key**

Press and hold:	Switch the system to sleep mode	
Single press:	Display the Display setup dialog	
Repeated presses:	Toggle preset backlight levels	



→ Note: If you hold down the power key after the display is turned to sleep mode, the unit will reboot and a Power failure alarm will be activated. Press any other key on the unit to silence the alarm.

8	lcon available if a thruster is installed. The icon will be shaded when the truster is deactivated for steering		
	Active alerts. Red icon for alarms, orange for warnings, yellow for cautions		
m-O	Locked control unit		
•	Picture freeze indicator. Two dots alternate slowly to show that the screen is alive and that information from sensors is updated		



Option	Result
Acknowledge	Sets the alarm state to acknowledged, meaning that you are aware of the alarm condition. The siren/buzzer stops and the alarm dialog is removed. However, the alarm remains active in the alarm listing until the reason for the alarm has been removed.

Silence	Mutes the siren locally (for 30 seconds) for all units in the same network alarm group. The alert dialog remains on the display.	
Close	Caution messages time-out, you can close the alert message pop-up.
